# JobKeeper delivers for Corangamite residents

With some 5,200 Corangamite businesses being supported by the **JobKeeper** program, the Morrison Liberal Government's \$1,500 a fortnight wage subsidy is keeping **Australians in work** and businesses in business.

JobKeeper is providing an **economic lifeline** to more than 850,000 businesses and is expected to assist around 3.5 million employees. The Australian Government has launched a **voluntary app**, COVIDSafe, to help health officials notify people who have been exposed to COVID-19. # **ECONOMIC RESPONSE TO COVID-19**

The Australian Government is delivering a range of initiatives to help families and businesses get through the COVID-19 pandemic, including:

#### **Support for Individuals**

### **JobKeeper Payment**

A JobKeeper Payment of \$1,500 per eligible employee, per fortnight. This is paid to employers to keep people in jobs.

### Stimulus payments

Two separate \$750 payments to social security, veteran and other income support recipients and eligible concession card holders.

### Early release of superannuation

The Government will allow individuals in financial stress as a result of COVID-19 to access up to \$10,000 of their superannuation in 2019-20 and a further \$10,000 in 2020-21.

#### Online courses

Investing \$7 million to support short courses to provide new skills to Australians who have lost their jobs or are looking to retrain. Course information can be found at **www.courseseeker.edu.au.** 

#### **Support for Businesses**

### **JobKeeper Payment**

This will help businesses significantly impacted by COVID-19 to continue paying eligible employees.

### Increasing the instant asset write-off

Lifting the threshold to \$150,000 (from \$30,000) and making more businesses eligible to use it. This has been extended to 31 December 2020.

#### Backing business investment

Offering businesses a time-limited 15 month incentive to invest, by accelerating depreciation deductions.

#### Supporting apprentices and trainees

Wage assistance to help small businesses to keep their apprentices and trainees.

#### Cash flow boost for business

The Government is providing temporary cash flow support of up to \$100,000 to eligible small and medium-sized businesses, and not-for-profits, so they can keep operating, pay their rent, electricity and other bills and retain staff.

# BOOSTING HOME CONSTRUCTION TO CREATE JOBS AND GROW OUR ECONOMY

The Morrison Government is supporting local jobs in the residential construction sector with the introduction of the new HomeBuilder grant which will run until 31 December 2020.

Eligible owner-occupiers, not just first home buyers, can apply for a one-off grant of \$25,000 to build a new home or rebuild an existing home.

The grant will be available for building new homes up to a value of \$750,000 or rebuilding projects worth between \$150,000 and \$750,000.

HomeBuilder will help boost jobs in the construction sector while also making it more affordable for families to build or rebuild their home.

This year, the Government also delivered the First Home Loan Deposit Scheme to help eligible first home buyers purchase their first home with a deposit of as little as 5 per cent, allowing them to get into the market sooner.





### SUPPORTING AUSTRALIAN EXPORTERS

We are supporting our export sector to get access to business-saving finance with a new \$500 million fund to keep Australian exporters operating and protect jobs in these tough times.

### **INVESTING IN COVID-19 RESEARCH**



Australia has world class institutions and researchers who are working hard to find a vaccine and treatment for COVID-19. We are providing \$66 million in funding research with four target areas:

- 1. Investing in a vaccine for COVID-19
- 2. Investing in antiviral therapies for COVID-19
- 3. Clinical trials of potential treatments for COVID-19
- **4. Improving** the health system's response to COVID-19 and future pandemics

## LOOKING AFTER **YOUR WELLBEING**

COVID-19 and self-isolation can be stressful and impact our mental health and wellbeing. Staying healthy, informed, positive and connected are all important. There are support services available if you, or someone you know, needs help.

The Morrison Government has invested an additional \$122.1 million to expand mental health services during COVID-19, bringing our total mental health budget in 2019-20 to more than \$5.2 billion. This includes funding to a range of mental health providers including more than \$24.2 million to headspace to fast track access to mental health services for young people aged 12-25.

The Geelong City Deal, backed by \$183 million from the Morrison Liberal Government, is delivering key projects to drive our visitor economy including the **Apollo Bay** Harbour upgrade, **Skenes Creek** coastal walk, Point Grey development in **Lorne** and a new ferry terminal in **Queenscliff**.



The rail duplication between Waurn Ponds and South Geelong and the upgrade of the Waurn Ponds, Marshall and South Geelong stations will deliver **faster, more reliable** train services. Stage 1 works, which will deliver a second platform and pedestrian overpass at Waurn Ponds station with some duplicated track, are now underway.



Backed by \$20 million from the Morrison Liberal Government, Avalon's international airport is **critical infrastructure** for our region. That is why it's so important to open our international borders as soon as it is safe to do so.



After a hard fought community campaign, the Morrison Liberal Government is delivering \$10 million for a **Bellarine outdoor 50 metre pool** with local council (we are asking the State Government to fund a stage 2 indoor pool facility) and \$20 million for the **Surf Coast Aquatic Centre** which needs another \$9 million from the State. The Morrison Liberal Government has proudly committed **\$2 billion** to deliver faster rail between Geelong and Melbourne, to be overseen by the National Faster Rail Agency. 
