Project description

This project will duplicate four kilometres of Barwon Heads Road, from Settlement Road to Reserve Road in Charlemont. The upgrade will also:

- build a new bridge over the railway line at Marshall, remove the level crossing
- upgrade multiple intersections
- install new street lighting, road signage, drainage and landscaping.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 292 direct and indirect jobs.

Project benefits

Benefits include:

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start in mid 2021 and be finished by late 2023.
